



LUZA Lab – Call for entries

After two successful editions in the municipality of Loulé, LUZA Festival (Algarve International Festival of Light) arrives at this third edition with news.

The Algarve Festival of Lights this year will be in FARO, with the same goals: offer a differentiating event in the city, by positively influencing tourism and trade in the region, in a low season.

During the last editions, the event received more than 60 thousand visitors, who were able to admire works by national and international artists, already renowned in the world of lighting installations as well as works of young artists whose raw material is light. The public could contemplate and interact with the artist installation during the event.

One of the objectives of LUZA is to become a national and international reference in the festivals of light around the world, but always united to the promotion of the culture, customs and traditions of the Algarve.

Once again, the Festival includes in the program LUZALAB, open to new and young artists who can present and produce their works and artistic ideas during LUZA Festival. A space to showcase your creativity and art.

CALL FOR ENTRIES: LUZA LAB 2019

Procedures to follow: The Festival will include young artists in the LUZA LAB program, which offers a budget, 1.500 euros, for the artists to develop projects for the designated venues, according to the artworks presented.

The Jury will be composed by 4 elements: ByBeau, Eventors'Lab, a responsible (tbc) for the city hall of Faro and Eurologistix.



To subscribe is required:

- Have up to 30 years (on the day of the event)
- Be a Portuguese citizen or legally resident in Portugal
- Algarve residents will have a 10% increase in the valuation
- If you fulfil these requirements, send the following items by e-mail:

Name	Age	Intervention site	Project, design and description
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The project must include:

- An artistic file that contains: the project, descriptive document, synopsis or a note of intention, visual simulations (photos, videos...)
- A complete technical file, presenting you equipment and organization (including an identified technical manager)
- A presentation team of the references of the different artists in the project (CV's)
- Balanced/Detailed budget

Only one project will be accepted per application.

Only complete files will be accepted and analysed.

Submissions are accepted until **September 30th**, 2019 inclusive.

Results will be presented on October 7th, on the website of LUZA, as well as in the social networks of the Festival.
